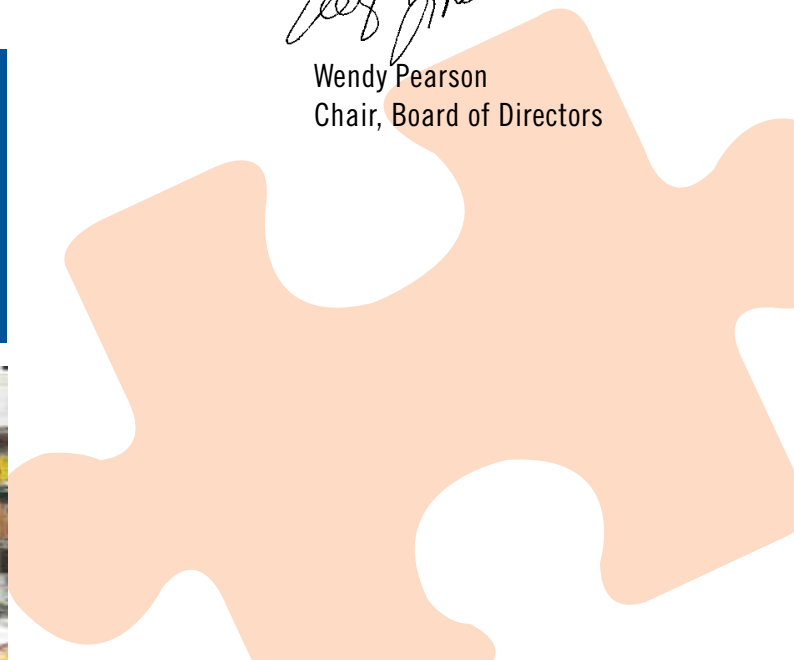

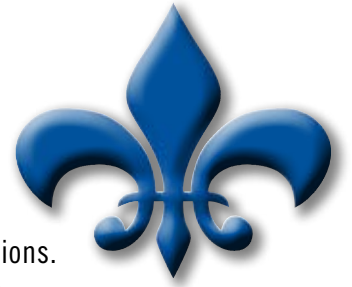

## Leadership Giving and Resource Development

Former State Senator Ed H. Price, Jr. established the United Way of Manatee County Leadership Program in 1983. In its first year, 51 individuals became members of the Pathfinders Club by contributing \$500 or more, and generated more than \$25,000 in contributions. Since its inception, the Leadership Giving Program has grown to include the Keel Club and the Tocqueville Society. Current Leadership Giving exceeds \$1 million with more than 680 members in the Pathfinder and Keel Clubs, and the Tocqueville Society.
